RUM RIDGE TRAIL REPORT

Thank you for helping me disseminate this information on the trails. I realize most of the year rounders already know their conditions and have been wonderful to help with their maintenance.

1. Lake Shore Trail

South of the boat launch there are two large trees down: one covers the trail and two are hanging over the trail. At the far end markers are needed. The north end of the trail is in good condition.

2. Deer Run Trail- Good condition

3. Rum Pond Trail

At the lake end there is a tree down and in the area between Deer Run and Crow's Corner there is a tree down.

4. Grenell Brook Trail

Near the blue trail end there is a tree down and further in a large one over the trail but you can walk around it.

5. Otter Slide Trail- Good condition

6. E. Grouse Trail

Near Otter Slide three trees down and further in two large trees block the trail.

7. W Grouse Trail- Good condition

8. Parking Area- Good condition

9. Partridge Pass Trail- Good condition

10. Rum Ridge Trail

Still has standing water on most of the trail.

11. Crow's Corner Trail- Good condition but needs a few markers.

12. Moose Hollow Trail- Good condition
